#### **Evaluation Criteria**

Entries are judged by an independent panel of expert judges drawn from the IRF's academic members. There is no limit to the number of entries an organization may submit. The selection panel is not obligated to select an award recipient in each of the eleven categories. Rather, the panel will recognize only those submissions that show outstanding merit. The panel also has the discretion to recognize submissions that do not win an award, yet nevertheless show exceptional merit.

Entries are open to projects that may have been recognized in other award programs, provided that they have not been recognized in a previous IRF Global Road Achievement Awards competition.

The criteria for the Global Road Achievement Awards are developed and reviewed regularly by the IRF Awards Committee. An independent selection panel will evaluate award submissions. No member of the selection panel may have an interest or bias related to the current applications. If a judge should have such an interest, that judge will be excused from reviewing the applicable entry(ies) and an alternate will be appointed. Awards will be presented to organizations which have submitted applications demonstrating:

- Complexity
- Replication capability
- Cost and efficiency considerations
- Technical value to road development industry
- Contributions to social and economic concerns
- Original or innovative use of existing technologies
- Original or innovative application of new technologies
- Development of new technologies, products or equipment
- A successful program, concept, or product on a specific project
- The surpassing of minimum regulatory requirements or industry standards
- Degree to which the project, meets the needs of the public, industry, owner or client

The selection panel is expected to name recipients of the Global Road Achievement Awards on or before October 1, 2013.

#### **Application Process**

The application package must include:

- 1. A completed application form
- 2. A project summary (~500 words)
- 3. An explanation of how the project meets the criteria of the category in which it has been submitted (~100 words)
- 4. PowerPoint™ presentation (.PPT or .PPTX only) including but not limited to slides, photographs, drawings, diagrams, videos, or additional explanatory materials (presentations should be limited to 30 slides or less)

Incomplete applications will not be considered. All materials must clearly identify the name of the project, the award category, and contact information of the submitting applicant.

#### Please note:

- 1. The submission of copyrighted material to the IRF for the Global Road Achievement Awards shall constitute a general grant of permission to the IRF to use the materials for promotional purposes.
- 2. Each application package must be accompanied by a non-refundable entry fee. A separate application package (accompanied by payment of the entry fee) must be submitted for each project entered in each category.
- 3. Entry packages must be received by the IRF, at the address listed below, by 5:00pm EST on June 30, 2013. Entries must be addressed to:
